



Program for Artists 2008

Overview

Welcome to our program for living artists. To qualify, you need to:

- be alive
- have sold 2 or more works for over \$125 each in the past.

If you meet the requirements, the program works as follows:

1. You are eligible to e-mail us your biography and an image of yourself. Please note that we must be granted permission to post your biography on our site.
2. You are eligible to e-mail us an image (.jpg or .gif) and details about one original work. Please note that we must be granted permission to post the image on our site.
We will catalog it for life for free (normally it costs \$25) and e-mail you a login and letter of provenance. Upon selling the work, you can login and simply transfer the ownership to the new owner. Every time you update your biography, you are eligible to send us another work for another free listing.

To Participate:

Step 1: E-mail us your bio or a link to your bio (We must be granted permission to use this information on our website)

C. Use the following guide to get a feel for what we are looking for:

Field Name:	What to Enter:
Artist Name:	Please enter your name
Biography	Your biography/description of style
Nationality:	Can be more than one
Born/Died:	Quite obviously, you will have half of the equation here. We prefer the format (1938 ~) for living artists.
Compiled by:	If you did not write your bio, add the person's name and we'll credit them
Noted Works and Exhibitions:

Step 2: And We'll list your work for life

A. To list your work for free, send an e-mail to admin@provenanced.com with a .jpg or .gif image of your work and as many details as you like.

We require at a minimum: the work title, the year created, The estimated sales price (not greater than 25% higher than any 2 comparable works you have sold in the last three years), the dimensions, the medium, the style and the provenance (which is at this point usually just, created year and location). Any description would also be greatly appreciated.
